To Our Residents, Family Members and Staff at Noel Manor Retirement Living --

We conducted our fourth round of facility wide testing on Tuesday, February 1st, 2022. We received the results this morning. We are happy to report that there are no new positive cases amongst staff members and no new positives amongst residents for the second week in a row.

We are following all isolation and quarantining protocol until quarantine periods have been completed for previous positive individuals. We have implemented additional monitoring for residents and team members that may have come in contact with an affected person. We will also continue to track and monitor all residents and team members for any COVID related symptoms.

With the no new positives for the second week in a row, we will be discontinuing testing at this time. We will continue to encourage residents to wear a mask when out of their apartments and in common areas. In addition, we have reinstated the usage of shields for team members.

We will work closely with residents to assist them with properly wearing their masks and socially distancing when appropriate outside of their unit, practicing good hand hygiene, and avoiding people or places where they are not able to wear a mask and socially distance. The nature of this virus makes it imperative for all residents and staff to remain healthy because we reside and work in a communal environment.
