To Our Residents, Family Members and Staff of Park Vista – Waupaca,

We received the results of our first round of testing and unfortunately, we received several new positive cases. We have already been in contact with our residents and team members at the building but wanted to follow up with a letter.

We have been in contact with the local health department and are following all isolation and quarantining protocol provided as well as guidance from DHS and the CDC. We will continue with our additional monitoring for residents and team members that may have come in contact with an affected person. We will also continue to track and monitor residents and team members for any COVID related symptoms. We will conduct weekly facility wide testing until we have two weeks of negative results. Per DHS and Public Health guidelines, we must continue to suspend in person visitation, communal dining and activities until all testing returns negative results.

We understand this is very difficult on family and residents to suspend in person visitation, but we will be scheduling in-booth visits, facetime calls as well as window visits through the quarantine period.

We will work closely with residents to assist them with properly wearing their masks and socially distancing when outside of their unit, practicing good hand hygiene, and avoiding people or places where they are not able to wear a mask and socially distance. The nature of this virus makes it imperative for all residents and staff to remain healthy because we reside and work in a communal environment.
