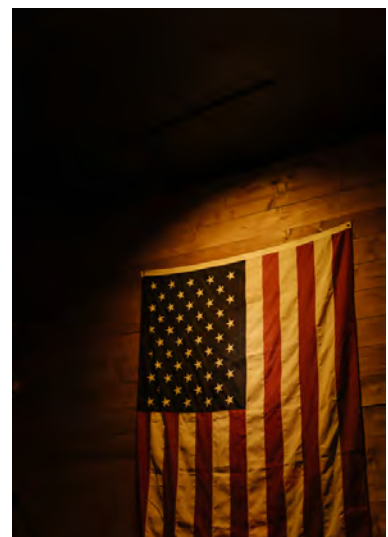
This month, we encourage you to soak up the season. Let the warmth of summer energize you, lift your spirits, and remind you that life is truly in full bloom.
