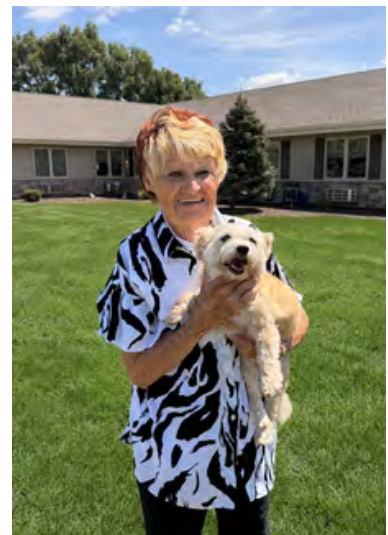
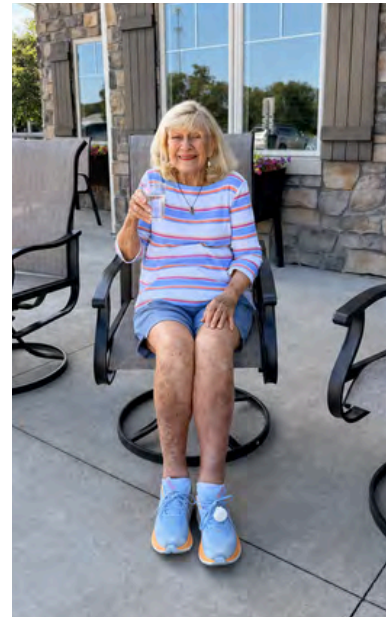
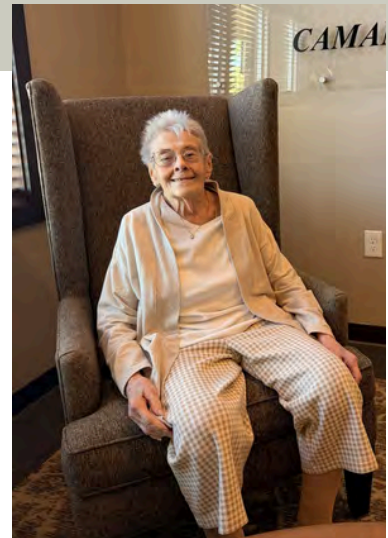
August Fun facts.
